Federal and state authorities are deploying unprecedented resources to root out corruption and related fraud against the government. Qui tam, under the False Claims Act, allows persons and entities with evidence of fraud against federal programs or contracts to sue the wrongdoer on behalf of the United States Government. WMH defends against false claims, and matters brought by whistleblowers to challenge the misuse of government resources.
