## **Experience**

- Conducted an independent investigation on behalf of the Board of Director into a nonprofit organization's management and culture stemming from allegations of racism and bullying by the organization's CEO.

  the Human Rights Council of the U.N. concerning the death of the Saudi journalist, Jamal
